INTERNET CONECTIVITY / WI-FI:

Wi-Fi is complimentary and does not require a password. Join "HO Members," and you will be automatically connected.

ENTERTAINMENT:

All of our in-room TVs are smart TVs. The televisions in all lodging units are serviced with DirecTV.

How to Use: The TV input should be on HDMI to receive channels. Pressing the guide button on your remote allows you to browse channels. On your remote control, use the up-arrow and down-arrow to switch from channel to channel. Once you have found the channel that you would like to watch, press "enter." The volume is controlled by the volume up and down arrows on the controller.

IN-ROOM SAFE:

For your convenience, an in-room safe is available for your use and is located in your room's walk-in closet. A four-digit code is needed to LOCK or UNLOCK the safe.

COFFEE MAKERS:

All lodging units are equipped with Nespresso Coffee Makers.

How to Use: Open the capsule compartment by pulling the lever forward, towards the spout. Place the Nespresso capsule with the silver part facing the spout. Pull the lever back to engage the capsule. Place a cup under the spout. Turn on the power by pressing the button displaying a coffee mug icon. The coffee machine will brew in about 30 seconds. Once the coffee is brewed, pull the lever back to drop the capsule into the tray for disposal.

FIREPLACES:

The fireplace is controlled by remote control.

How to Use: Press 'ON' to light the fire. CAUTION: DO NOT hold the 'ON' button down for longer than three seconds. It may take a few seconds before the fire ignites. To turn the fire off, press 'OFF' on the remote control. Please note that the pilot light will remain on.

INSECTS, SNAKES & OTHER CRITTERS:

Our lodging accommodations are situated in natural, wooded areas and nestled within the canopies of majestic Live Oak trees, without storm doors or window screens. As such lodging guests are reminded to keep doors and windows closed as much as possible to keep insects and other creatures of nature on the outside. Should you encounter an outside critter on the inside of your accommodation, please contact Member Services (936-372-4312) or the Welcome Gate (936-372-4327) for assistance.

Policies

QUIET TIME:

Quiet time at the Inn and Cottages is observed nightly between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. to ensure the comfort and convenience of all guests.

PETS:

In deference to our many Guests who may suffer from pet allergies, pets are not allowed in any of the lodging accommodations located on the main Houston Oaks campus, which includes The Inn at Houston Oaks, Cottages and the Lodge. Pets are also not permitted in the Clubhouse, including the restaurant and locker room patios.

Leashed pets are welcome at The Park House, the Ranch House and the Ranch Cabin. A non-refundable pet fee of \$150 per pet, per stay will be charged in pet friendly lodging venues. Members and Guests who bring pets into lodging venues that are not pet friendly will be charged a non-refundable pet fee of \$300 per pet, per night.

Service dogs are welcome in pet-restricted areas; the owner of the service animal may be requested to provide the animal's service card or the animal must be wearing a visible service animal vest. Please advise us of pets and service animals in advance of your stay to include the name and breed of each animal.

SMOKING:

All facilities at the Club are smoke-free. Smoking is only allowed on the terrace and patios of the accommodations. Please discard cigarette and cigar butts in the ashtrays that are provided. If smoking occurs in a public or private area, a cleaning fee of at least \$250 will be added to your account.

LOST AND FOUND:

Lost and found items may be claimed through the Director of Lodging or Member Services staff. Lost and found items will be kept for maximum of 60 days. After 60 days the Club will dispose of unclaimed items. Items may be shipped to members upon request. Shipping charges will apply.

CHILDCARE

The Club offers limited child-watching services by advance reservation.

Activity Leaders for this purpose may be available by appointment. During Club events, group childcare is often provided. Additional fees may apply, and RSVPs are essential. Waivers must be completed before service.

TRANSPORTATION

Golf Carts

Golf Carts are available to rent for licensed drivers age 16 and older who possess a valid driver's license. The Club offers a limited number of, four and six-seat capacity carts. Golf cart operators are requested to read the rules and regulations posted on the cart steering wheel before driving. Golf carts may be rented in the Sports/Tennis Shop, at which time a key will be provided. The Clubs at Houston Oaks management reserves the right, at our discretion, to withdraw golf carts that we deem are being misused or operated in an unsafe manner.

GOLF CLUB

Golf Club facilities include our 18-Hole Championship Course, 9-Hole Scrambler Course, Driving Range, Scrambler Practice Facility and Putting Greens, Men's and Women's Locker Rooms and a Full-Service Golf Shop with caddie services available. Soccer Golf and Disk Golf can also be played on the 9-Hole Scrambler Course.

DRESS CODE:

Proper attire is required for all players. Tee shirts, tank tops, halter tops, jeans, cutoffs, sweat-pants, tennis or other athletic shorts, and bathing suits are prohibited from all golf areas. For men, shirts with turtlenecks, mock turtlenecks, or collars and sleeves, slacks, and golf shorts with a minimum six-inch inseam are considered proper attire. For women, dresses, blouses, slacks, and golf shorts with a minimum six-inch inseam are considered proper attire.

Only soft spike or spike-less golf shoes or other approved shoes should be worn on the Golf Course and Practice Facilities. The golf staff must approve any shoes other than golf shoes.

Gun Club

Gun Club facilities include two (2) 5-stand shooting decks, an archery course and the Gun Club Grill. Firearms and ammunition are available to rent; shotgun storage is also available.

EQUESTRIAN RIDING CLUB

Equestrian facilities are available at the Houston Oaks Ranch and include; a lighted outdoor arena, private horse boarding, trail rides, riding lessons and instruction in western roping, reining, cutting, sorting and team penning.

FRIENDLY REMINDERS:

Boots with heels and long pants (jeans/denim) are required for all equestrian activities. Shorts and open-toed shoes, sandals and flip flops are not permitted.

Lessons and trail rides are available for ages 6 years old and up.

FISHING CLUB

Fishing Club facilities are headquartered at Fish Camp and include a tackle shop, bait shop, fishing pole lockers and lighted fishing dock. The Club features 17 lakes, all of which are stocked with red ear sunfish, channel catfish, bluegill sunfish, large-mouth bass, tilapia and crappie. Seasonally select lakes are stocked with rainbow trout which members are allowed to keep at the end of the season. Complimentary kayaks, paddle boards and pedal boats are available on the Clubhouse Lake between Memorial and Labor Day. The Welcome Gate is fully stocked with rentable fishing poles, tackle boxes and bait 24/7. Houston Oaks is a catch-and-release fishery; barbless hooks are required.



THEN | Alert the Front Desk of the Situation 936-372-4312.

IF THE FRONT DESK IS NOT AVAILABLE | Contact the Welcome Gate at 936-372-4327. The Welcome Gate attendant will be responsible for directing/escorting fire/ambulance to your location.

IN THE CASE OF A FIRE

EVALUATE | if you are able to safely put of the fire with an extinguisher.

IF NOT, EVACUATE IMMEDIATELY | Never open doors that are warm to the touch.

YELL "FIRE" | right away to attract assistance.

CONTACT 911 | then follow the remaining steps listed above.
